ASSESSMENT

Courses are assessed independently by a combination of coursework and assignments. Submission of a 15 credit Masters Dissertation defended in a public oral examination.

DOCTORATE Presentation of a Research Proposal, with the agreement of a tutor from the Masters Programme, to the Department and Research Committee. Doctoral thesis written under the supervision of the tutor and submitted to a Research Committee. Public defense.

ELIGIBILITY

This program is especially suitable for students who have had training in Linguistics or Linguistics and Education/Psychology. The courses are intended for all those interested in language and communication. Teachers of second/foreign languages interested in research in their own professional practice will find some courses specifically for this type of focus. Those interested in other areas of Applied Linguistics will find a number of courses on topics outside the field of education.

A good knowledge of English, at least at receptive level, is required

STRUCTURE AND LEVELS OF POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

The University offers opportunities for further study to those who already have a degree, and confers a Masters Degree, with the possibility of preparing a Doctoral Thesis.

- a student who successfully passes 60 credits will be awarded a **Masters Degree**;
- a student who, after having passed the 60 credits (courses and dissertation), wants to undertake a research project leading to a doctoral thesis will be awarded a **Doctorate/PhD Degree** if the research work, judged by a specialized Committee, is of sufficient quality and makes a definite contribution to knowledge.

DESCRIPTION AND AIMS

This programme is designed specifically to cover the needs of professionals working with languages -teachers, translators, and anyone working with two or more languages- and provides a solid background in relevant aspects of linguistics and language acquisition. It gives students the theory and practice necessary to be able to detect problems of communication and acquisition, analyse them and propose theoretically-based solutions.

In addition to the specific research interests of individual members of staff, the members of the programme have a number of active research groups. See descriptions on the web. Research students are particularly welcome to participate in the on-going work of these groups.
